

ID and Birth Certificate Assistance

What is it?

- A voucher to pay for an Oregon ID, birth certificate or other documentation needed to access employment or housing

Details:

- Five people chosen by lottery three times a week
- Can get help with both ID & birth certificate once every four years

Lottery Times:

- Tuesday, 2:00-2:30 PM
- Wednesday, 2:00 – 2:30 PM
- Thursday, 2:00 – 2:30 PM

Bring these to get in the lottery:

- Verification of income (less than \$700 monthly)
- Back up documentation
 - DMV requires a birth certificate before issuing an ID card.
 - Birth certificate requirements vary depending on the state.

TriMet Tickets

What is it?

- Tickets for bus or MAX

Details:

- Up to 10 tickets every 90 days
- For medical appointments or first week of a new job
- Bring phone # to call and verify

Hair Shop

What is it?

- Free haircuts

Details:

- On-site, Tuesdays & Thursdays. See an Engagement Specialist to sign up.
- Vouchers for off-site salon. Three vouchers available at the front desk Monday mornings.

Hygiene Center

What is it?

- **Showers:** 15 minute time slots. We provide towels, soap and shampoo.
- **Laundry:** Washers and dryers cost \$.75 each per load or 15 minutes of barter work to wash and dry a load. Detergent is included. You can do one barter load per week. Barter laundry is only available when the check in desk is open.
- **Clothing Room:** You can get one outfit per week. Sign up at 1:45 PM weekdays and 10:15 AM weekends.

Details:

- Sign up at the hygiene desk.
- The hygiene desk is open
 - **7 AM – 2 PM** weekdays
 - **8 AM – Noon** weekends and holidays.

Case Management

What is it?

- Case managers work with you to address housing barriers and find housing

Details:

- Talk with an Engagement Specialist to be pre-screened for case management orientation

Eviction Prevention/Deposit Assistance

What is it?

- Rent assistance to keep you in housing or move-in assistance to get housing

Details:

- Many requirements; ask one of the staff for an information sheet

Veteran's Services

What is it?

- For veterans and their families: Case management, rental assistance, benefits enrollment, and housing options.

Details:

- Veterans services sign-up Mondays at 8:00 AM
- Grant Per Diem Orientation (residential program). Sign-up Fridays at 7:00 AM

Residential Services Programs

What is it?

- Short-term, dorm style housing
- Jean's Place (women)
- Doreen's Place & Clark Center (men)

Details:

- An initial thirty day stay may be extended up to four months
- Work with case manager to address housing barriers
- Alcohol and drug free
- Two to four month wait list
- TB card required

Waitlist:

- Check in once a week
- When you are under #20 on the list, check in daily until you get into the program.

Lockers & Storage

What is it?

- Lockers for weekly or day use

Details:

- Day use lockers must be picked up 6:30 PM weekdays and 3:30 PM weekends and holidays
- Weekly lockers are available for a half hour of barter work per week and a \$5 refundable lock deposit.

Mailing Address / Message Service

What is it?

- Use Transition Projects as a mailing address and as a phone message service

Details:

- Must have photo ID to pick up mail
- Mailroom is open **Monday through Friday, 3 PM – 7 PM**
- Mail returned to sender if not picked up in two weeks
- Messages available at front desk

Dental Voucher

What is it?

- Tooth extraction at Multnomah County's Southeast Clinic

Details:

- No cleanings or preventive services.
- Must be homeless, with no income and no dental insurance
- One voucher available each weekday morning.

Food Box Voucher

What is it?

- A voucher to pick up a food box at First Baptist Church.

Details:

- Need picture ID and proof of downtown address.
- Can get one food box voucher every thirty days
